GENERAL TRIAL INFORMATION

Parents are advised that the Department of Education, Training and the Arts does not have Personal Accident Insurance cover for students. Education Queensland has public liability cover for all approved school activities and provides compensation for students injured at school / school events only when the Department is negligent. If this is not the case, then all costs associated with the injury are the responsibility of the parent or caregiver. It is a personal decision for parents as to the type and level of private insurance they arrange to cover students for any accidental injury that may occur.

COVID Guidelines for attendance at the trial

As per COVID requirements parents are to provide their name, mobile and email address in order for their child to attend the district trial. Parent information for the COVID register needs to be completed using the QR code on the district trial notice. Parents MUST register prior to the trial via the QR Code. Student CANNOT register via this code.

As you are aware, with the current 'Covid-Normal' status we are in, one of the requirements is to maintain an attendance register for attendees at public events – including our trial. This attendance register will contain personal contact information [Student Date of Birth, School Name, Parent email] that can be used for COVID-19 contact tracing purposes if required.

The details will be recorded on the attendance register beside your child's name and will only be passed onto public health unit if required for COVID-19 tracing purposes. This team attendance register will be stored at the regional sport office for the mandatory 56-day period. In line with this request, please read the privacy statement below provided by the Department of Education.

Privacy Statement

The Department of Education is collecting personal information of parents of State school and non-State school students, and any other persons in attendance, in accordance with the Information Privacy Principles prescribed under the Information Privacy Act 2009 (Qld), in order to record the details of parents and any other persons attending sporting

events, to enable the Department to comply with its obligations under the Public Health Act 2005 (Qld) and Disaster Management Act 2003 (Qld). This information will only be accessed by authorised staff within the department. Your personal information will not be given to any other person or agency without your permission or where we are required by law

Conditions of Attendance

If you or your child answers 'YES' to any question below, DO NOT ATTEND the District Trial as you will be refused access to the venue as per COVID-19 guidelines. Please contact the district coach or manager to arrange alternative trial information.

In the previous 14 days, have you

- currently or recently experienced cough, fever, sore throat, fatigue or shortness of breath?
- been in close contact with a person who is positive for COVID-19?
- Are you an active COVID-19 case?
- travelled from overseas or a COVID-19 hotspot?

At present the COVID-19 guidelines state:

- staff provide sanitiser for players on arrival and departure
- staff should sanitise additional team equipment before and after training [e.g. bats, catcher's gear]
- team members to bring their own water bottle
- staff to limit sharing of sharing of personal equipment as much as possible
- staff to maintain an attendance register for students
- staff to ensure adult spectators maintain 1.5m physical distancing and sign in using the QR code system
