Who can attend	Students born in 2014, 2015 or 2016.
What you need to do	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• See your PE teacher / school sport coordinator to pick up your 'trial information forms'.• Complete our 'District trial permission note / medical form / mouthguard note and have it signed by your school delegate.• Students need to bring your signed permission form and mouthguard note to the trial and hand it to the convenor. You will not be permitted to trial if you do not have this signed form. Do not hand it in at your school.• Wear your school sport shirt to our trial• Students should bring your own water bottle and any safety requirements of the sport. Please bring a glove (or one from your school) and any further equipment you require. Equipment will be available for those who do not have any.• A mouthguard may be worn for this trial• There is no cost to attend this trial.
How will we select our team	We will take into account the following when selecting our team: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ability - Level of skills exhibited at these trials.• Attitude – displayed to officials and fellow participants• Aptitude-the ability to take / interpret and action instructions.
Other information	We will pick one team with a maximum of 12 players. Our selected team will take part in the regional softball 10-12 years trial, 19/20 May. Venue for the Regional trial is Redcliffe District Softball Association, Boardman Road, Kippa-ring. Team members will need to pay the \$25 regional trial levy if selected .
