What you need to do:	Get school permission to come to our trial as their representative.
	Pick up our 'trial information pack' from your school sport coordinator.
	 Register online using our QR-Code on page 1 of our 'trial information pack' so that we know how many will be turning up to try out for our district team.
	Make sure you register by the closing date,
	11:00 pm Sunday 23 March 2025.
	We will not accept registrations after this date and time.
	 Please fill out your preferred playing positions when you are registering to assist district team officials prepare for our trial.
	 Fill out our permission forms (including our mouthguard form). We will use these forms at our trial and for team training sessions if you are selected in our district team.
What you need to bring:	You must wear a mouthguard when taking part in our trial.
	 Bring your filled out forms (including our mouthguard form) to hand them in at the start of our trial.
	Bring your own water bottle with water in it.
	Bring your own head protective gear if you wear it.
	Strapping tape if you wear it. Please put it on before we begin our trial.

What to wear:

- Wear suitable football boots
- Remove all jewellery.

What we will consider for team selection:

We will use the following criteria when considering you for selection in our team:

- You need to have very high playing skill levels in this sport.
- Previous playing experience in this sport is an advantage.
- You must have excellent kicking and catching skills.
- You must be able to demonstrate your ability to handle physical contact.

Other information:

- First aid and ice will be available.
- If we pick you in our team, you must come along to all our team training sessions and train with the team.
