Multi-class information sheet



Dear family members of multi-class athletes

Our representative school sport program provides multi-class athletes with opportunities to take part in multi-class events.

If your child is capable of safely competing in available multi-class track and field events, please nominate by filling out our [multi-class nomination form](#) and sending it to your child's school sport co-ordinator by the nomination deadline.

Ask your school to help you fill out the multi-class nomination form.

This form includes a multi-class classification guide to help you figure out what multi-class classification your child belongs to. It also has other very important and essential information on it that you need to know.

If your child does not have a formal multi-class classification, don't worry. They can still take part in district and regional track and field trials. But they will not be able to take part in the Queensland Representative School Sport state track and field championship until they have an official multi-class classification issued to them.

Multi-class athletes who are nominating to take part in a district or region track and field trial must also fill out and sign :

- A [QRSS student consent form](#) (please get this form from your school or from the school district)
- If your child wants to take part in discus or javelin, then the [QRSS certificate of competence, consent, medical declaration form](#) also must be filled out and signed. This form can be signed by a registered teacher with qualifications in HPE and who is competent in teaching discus and javelin.
